• Pre-bid Conference PR21-069: 1 Lot Oracle Database Appliance Upgrade, ABC: 20,500,000.00	 Matters raised for clarification/modification are as follows: D.6 Training Requirement. The end-user clarified that the knowledge transfer requirement is to let ITSS personnel who would lead the project have information about the upgrade. The end-user is not requiring ITSS personnel be given a badge after the training. Modification of D.8 Certification Requirement from "The bidder must submit a current and valid Certification from the Product Manufacturer or Principal stating that the bidder is an Authorized Oracle University Partner to delivers and conduct Trainings." to "The bidder must submit a current and valid Certification from the Product Manufacturer." D.9 Oracle Certified Professionals (OCP) Requirement. The end-user clarified that they are requiring submission of OCP documentations and certifications to ensure that the supplier who would be providing the upgrade are competent in oracle. Scope of Migration. The end-user clarified that the existing oracle standard edition schemas would be migrated to enterprise edition (ODA) thru backup, export and import facilities of Oracle. The BAC informed the prospective bidders that additional requests for clarifications on any part of the bidding documents may still be submitted in writing and may be sent electronically to the BAC on or before 21 August 2021. The BAC shall issue its response by issuing a Bid Bulletin. The bid bulletin will be posted on or before
