TERMS OF REFERENCE

Procurement of Souvenir Jackets
(Purchase Request No. 23-081)

BRIEF DESCRIPTION

Procurement of two hundred ten (210) pieces Souvenir Jackets for the 22nd AMLC Anniversary celebration.

The Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is Three Hundred Fifteen Thousand Pesos (PhP315,000.00) plus 10% contingency of Thirty-One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP31,500.00), or a total ABC of Three Hundred Forty-Six Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP346,500.00).

INSTRUCTIONS TO SUPPLIERS

Form of Quotation:

Suppliers¹ are required to submit its Quotation using the Prescribed Form (See Page 5) by the Anti-Money Laundering Council (AMLC).

Documentary Requirements:

GENERAL CONDITIONS

Quotation Price:

Supplier's quotation shall be inclusive of all costs, applicable taxes, charges, fees and other incidental expenses, including, but not limited to notarial expenses.

Quotation Validity Period:

Quotations shall be valid for thirty (30) calendar days from receipt by the BAC Secretariat.

Delivery Period/Completion Period/Contract Period:

Delivery period shall be on or before 15 December 2023.

Liquidated Damages:

- A delay by the Supplier in the full delivery of the goods/services shall render the Supplier liable for liquidated damages, which shall be deducted by the AMLC from each payment or total contract price in case of one-time payment.
- Liquidated damages shall be equal to one-tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the total contract price for every day of delay.

Payment:

- Payments shall be made only upon the issuance of the **Inspection and Acceptance Report (IAR)**² by the IAC.
- No payment shall be made for supplies and materials not yet delivered or services not yet rendered.
- The Supplier's request for payment shall be made in writing, accompanied by an invoice describing, as appropriate, the goods delivered and/or services performed, and by documents submitted pursuant, and upon fulfillment of other obligations stipulated in these Terms of Reference.
- Payments shall be made promptly by the AMLC within thirty (30) days from issuance of the IAR by the IAC.
- The currency in which payment is to be made shall be in Philippine Pesos.
- The payment of 10% contingency shall be based on actual consumption. The unutilized portion of the contingency fund shall not be released and will revert to the AMLC funds.

Warranty:


- The Supplier warrants that the goods supplied are new, unused, of the most recent or current models, and that they incorporate all recent improvements in design and materials. The Supplier also warrants that all goods supplied shall have no patent or latent defect, arising from design, materials, or workmanship or from any act or omission of the Supplier that may develop under normal use of the supplied goods in the conditions prevailing in the country of final

destination. The Supplier further warrants that the goods supplied is fit for the use for which it was intended.

- The AMLC shall promptly notify the Supplier in writing of any claims arising under the warranty. Upon receipt of such notice, the Supplier shall, within 7 days and with all reasonable speed, repair or replace the defective goods or parts thereof, without costs to the AMLC. If the Supplier, having been notified, fails to remedy the defects within the period specified in the contract, the AMLC may proceed to call upon the warranty security, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have against the Supplier under these Terms of Reference and under the applicable law.

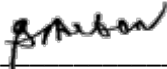

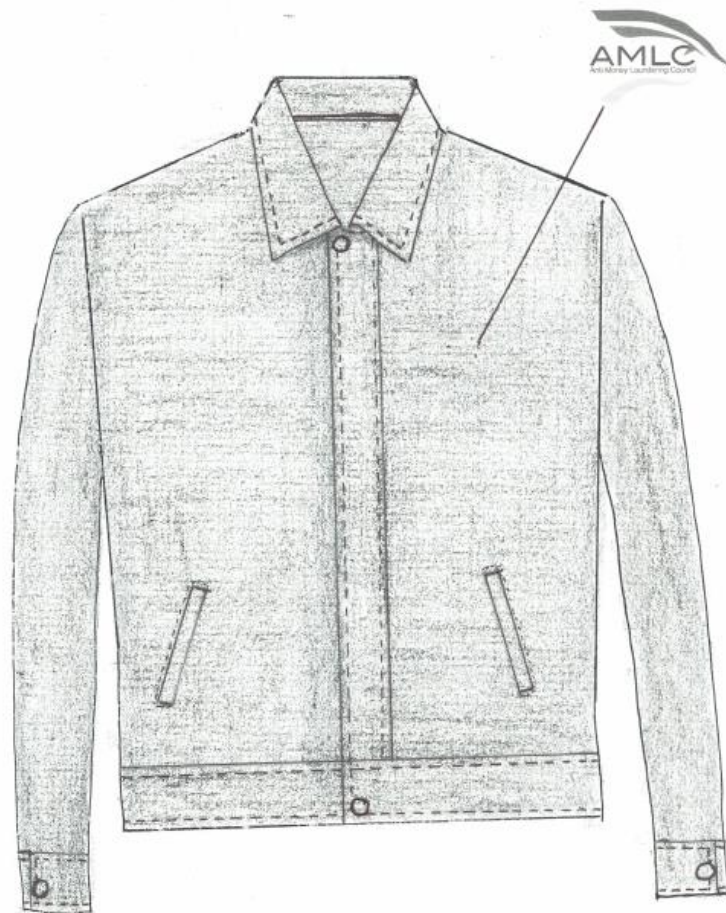
